## BODDINGTONS PUB ALE 4.25

*Boddingtons, Manchester, UK*



4.7% ABV 27 IBU 16 oz.  
*Using nitrogen and lightly-kilned English malt, Boddingtons produces a rich, slightly sweet English ale with a thick and creamy head.*

## FULLERS ESB 4.5

*London, England*



5.5% ABV 16 oz.  
*Easy-drinking with a rich nutty, grainy aroma with spicy hops and hints of orange and lemon mellowing out over warm malt flavors.*

## STONE IPA 4.95

*Stone Brewing Company, Escondido, CA*



6.9% ABV 16 oz.  
*Light-medium malt character with a heavy dose of hops. Two full weeks of "dry hopping" give this beer its abundant hop aroma and crisp flavor.*

## SPATEN OKTOBERFEST 4.5

*Spaten Brewery, Munich, Germany*



5.9% ABV 16 oz.  
*The world's first Oktoberfest beer, created in 1872 for the "greatest folk festival in the world." Medium bodied, amber in color with rich roasted malt flavor.*

## LONG TRAIL IPA 4.5

*Long Trail Brewery, Bridgewater Corners, VT*



5.9% ABV 16 oz.  
*A traditional IPA: unfiltered with dry-hopped additions and crisp citrus flavor with a grassy finish.*

## AMERICAN PALE ALE 4.5

*Stoudt's Brewery, Adamstown, PA*



5% ABV 16 oz.  
*A unique American beer with a crisp, medium body, refreshing bitterness and a vibrant citrus aroma.*

## PUMPKINHEAD 4.5

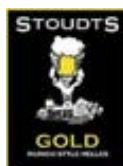
*Shipyards Brewery, Portland, ME*

# BEER GLOSSARY

---

**Abbey Ale:** Belgian strong ale brewed by or under license from monasteries, although not all have monastic links.

**Bitter:** British-style beer that is usually well hopped.

**Blonde / Blond Ale:** European name for light-colored golden ale, often French or Belgian in origin.

**Bock:** German term for strong beer that was once brewed only seasonally. Stronger versions include Doppelbock and Eisbock.

**Copper:** Vessel used in the brewing process to boil the sugary wort with hops. Also known as a brew kettle.

**Doppelbock / Double bock:** An extra-strong German-style bock, often of an ABV around 7.5% or more.

**Dubble / Double:** A Belgian-style abbey ale that describes a strong dark ale.

**Dunkel:** Means “dark” in German and describes dark lagers and dark wheat beers.

**Extra Special Bitter (ESB):** A bigger and bolder version of bitter, often with additional hop character.

**Golden Ale:** Pale ales with a moderate hop content, rarely exceeding 5%. These ales straddle the line between lager and bitter.

**Hefeweizen:** Hefe means “yeast” in German and this is a naturally conditioned German-style wheat beer with sediment.

**Hops:** A climbing plant with cones containing acids, resins and tannins that produces aroma and bitterness in beer to complement the natural sweetness of malt.

**IPA:** Short for India Pale Ale, a heavily hopped beer which was first brewed in Burton-on-Trent, England in the 19th century to survive the long journey to India.

**Kolsch:** A type of top-fermented light golden ale first brewed in and around the city of Cologne, Germany.

**Lager:** A range of beer styles created by bottom-fermenting (or cold-fermenting) in tanks where the temperature is just above freezing. As yeast settles at the bottom of the tank, a slow secondary fermentation occurs, carbonation increases and beer emerges.

**Lambic:** A style of Belgian beer originating from tiny, rural breweries in the Payottenland region. It is fermented using airborne wild yeasts that cause spontaneous fermentation. When cherries or raspberries are added, the beers are known as kriek and framboise, respectively.
